Welcome to Megan, she will start to introduce herself to all parents over the next couple of weeks.

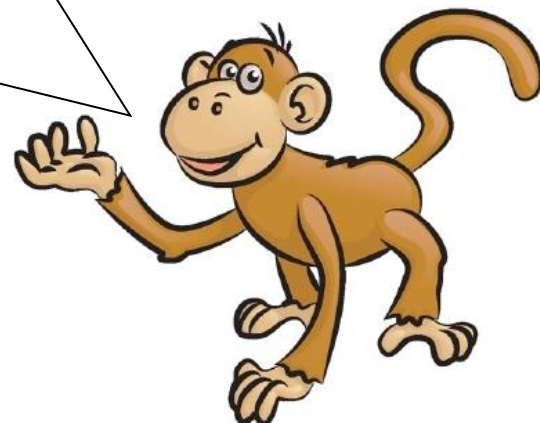
Kim is also now Room Leader.

from their holidays and all our new starters.

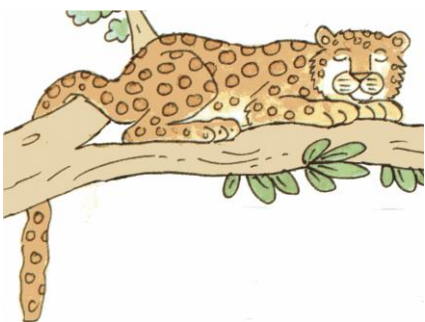
We would like to welcome Kimberley to the room
