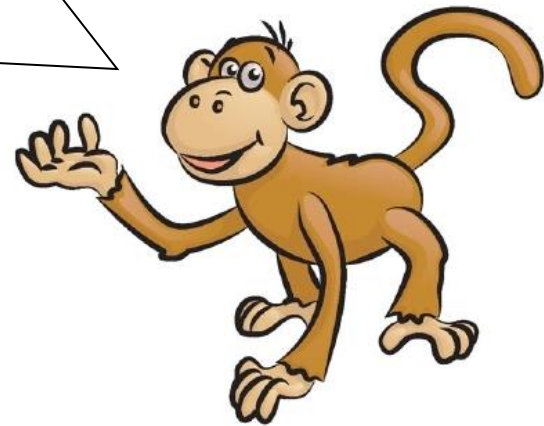
Messages from the rooms...
